Have you forgotten someone's name? Or someone's birthday? Or your wedding anniversary? Or an important appointment? Or where you left your keys, phone or purse/wallet? How do you remember things? Do you write them down? Or put them in your diary? Or set an alarm? Because our memory is predominantly visual, it's good to associate the words you want to remember with an image. Because we remember things that are repeated, it's good to create a routine for things we want to remember.
